## Hose Science News

Quarterly we produce a 4-page newsletter/teachers resource. These are distributed directly to schools as teachers' packs and include state standard aligned lesson plans for teachers to utilize. Each issue has a specific theme. The "headline sponsor gets to pick the theme, for example our inaugural sponsor, CFC Recycling, had their issue all about recycling.

The lessons and activities tie into that theme as well as a large back cover article tying the theme directly to the headline sponsor. \$500 and \$250 support sponsors available
